Logistical Information about the programme

Set Up Time: 10 minutes. Marcelle will arrive about 20 minutes before the start time.

Requirements: A white board & if possible; a lectern, small table & music stand.

If the participants are seated on the floor Marcelle will speak from the floor.

If the participants are seated on chairs it works better for her to speak from a stage or raised podium.

Duration: Actual Performance: 65 – 75 - 90 minutes.

Additional time is needed $\underline{\text{before}}$ the performance for the participants arrive at the venue and settle.

Pack up Time: 10 minutes. Marcelle will collect the cheque from the office and leave a receipt.

Tailoring

Sessions can be tailored for the group.

- English departments have requested focus on Oral Presentation, Speech Competition, Drama or Debating.
- Careers Officers have requested focus on Personal Development or Interview Skills.
- Other schools have chosen to have the sessions focus on Communication; in Leadership Team Building, Inspiration & Practical Motivation etc.

Suitability?

Marcelle uses the participants response to the 1st 10 minutes of the programme to gage what level of information and participation is appropriate to their level of interest and ability to concentrate. The programme is then tailored to each audience. The sessions are useful for all participants who want strong communication skills but they are particularly suitable for participants who are weaker in the areas of reading and writing.

Participation?

Participation is encouraged but not required. All participants are invited to participate as a group. The programme s also include opportunities for up to 10 participants to participate individually. Primary school participants are usually leaping up of the floor to "Have a Go". Naturally less participation occurs as participants move towards the end of high school. Smaller schools often arrange for another school in the area to visit for the session. This is a great way to start inter-school debating or public speaking competitions to motivate students.

Participants that participate during the session are acknowledged and rewarded.
